NOTE:

- 1. The noise level emitted from the property may not exceed 95 dBA.
- 2. A qualified acoustic engineer or an accredited acoustic consultant (not a sound engineer), must at all times during the event, take and record the emitted noise levels and hand a report containing the findings, to the Municipality within two (2) working days after the completion of the event. The engineers cost will be borne by the applicant.
- The location and/or orientation of loudspeaker equipment should be taken into account in order to minimize noise emissions into the potentially noise sensitive areas.
- 4. The event should be advertised by means of leaflets or the media in order to inform the residents in the vicinity of the event.
- 5. The Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Police Department, Disaster Management, Emergency Services as well as the South African Police Services must be informed of the event and proof thereof must be submitted to this department in order to consider your application.

PLEASE NOTE THAT IF AN EVENT IS CANCELLED OR CALLED OFF, THE RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL MUST IMMEDIATELY BE NOTIFIED THEREOF IN WRITING, WHICH WILL RESULT IN THE CANCELLATION / LAPSE OF THIS APPLICATION.
