

DRIVING SKILLS AND ANGER MANAGEMENT

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RESOLVED:

1. **That** the report on insurance claims for the period 1 July 2008 up until 30 June 2009 attached to the report as **Annexures "A" and B" BE NOTED.**
2. **That** it **BE NOTED** that Council Resolution A-F (27-2003) dated 27 March 2003 became obsolete and that it **BE RESCINDED.**
3. **That** the following actions **BE IMPLEMENTED:**
 - 3.1 **That** the Loss Control Committee **BE REVIVED** with immediate effect and active participation by all Departments **BE MADE COMPULSORY.**
 - 3.2 **That** the Departments who are in charge of infrastructure **PRIORITIZE** funding towards preventative maintenance programmes such as Electricity and Roads Infrastructure.
 - 3.3 **That** the Departments who control Security Contracts **REVISE** such contracts to include penalty clauses and **IMPLEMENT** more monitoring controls to limit relevant exposure to losses.
 - 3.4 **That** the Human Resource Management & Development Department processes of screening personnel **BE INTENSIFIED** to ensure that people are not appointed in positions which poses a high risk for the employer.
 - 3.5 **That** no personnel **BE ALLOWED** to drive EMM vehicles without appropriate skills being tested.
 - 3.6 **That** specialised courses such as advanced driving courses and anger management **BE MADE COMPULSORY** for staff requiring these skills in the execution of their duties, such as staff in the EMPD and Emergency Services Section.
 - 3.7 **That** the Executive Manager: Enterprise Wide Risk Management position in the Office of the City Manager **BE FILLED** by no later than 01 November 2009 and **BE TASKED** to produce an Enterprise Wide Risk Management Strategy to mitigate risks on an annual basis.
4. **That** the progress report **BE SUBMITTED** to the respective portfolios by not later than 30 October 2009 with the recommendation that after such items have served in respective portfolios, these **BE REFERRED** to the Finance Portfolio Committee.
