**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF VALIDITY: FOR CONTRACT A-EE 22-2024:
THE APPOINTMENT OF A PANEL OF CONTRACTORS TO ASSIST THE CITY OF
EKURHULENI'S ENERGY DEPARTMENT WITH THE NEW CONSTRUCTION AND
UPGRADE WORKS OF VARIOUS SUBSTATIONS, SWITCHING STATIONS PROJECTS
AND POWER FACTOR CORRECTION SPECIAL WORKS AND HIGH VOLTAGE
PROJECTS, ON AN AS-AND-WHEN REQUIRED BASIS FROM DATE OF AWARD UNTIL
30 JUNE 2027.**

The validity period for Contract number A-EE 22-2024 will expire on 03 December 2024.

Paragraph 16.6.5 of the City of Ekurhuleni Supply Chain Management (SCM) Policy states that: *"SCM shall ensure that an extension of validity period is published on the City's website before the validity period expiry date. Should no response be received within 7 days, from date of publishing, the City will consider the bid offer/s valid for the stated period. It is the responsibility of a bidder to continuously check the City's website for updates on the validity period of advertised bids"*.

The extension of validity of contract A-EE 22-2024 which will expire on 03 December 2024 is hereby extended until 28 February 2025
