SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF VALIDITY: A-EE 14 -2024: THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND OFF LOADING OF STEEL DISTRIBUTION AND STREET LIGHT POLES AND BRACKETS ON AN AS AND WHEN REQUIRED BASIS FROM DATE OF AWARD UNTIL 30 JUNE 2027.

The validity period for Contract number A-EE 14 -2024 expired on the 17 October 2024.

Paragraph 16.6.5 of the City of Ekurhuleni Supply Chain Management (SCM) Policy states that: "SCM shall ensure that an extension of validity period is published on the City's website before the validity period expiry date. Should no response be received within 7 days, from date of publishing, the City will consider the bid offer/s valid for the stated period. It is the responsibility of a bidder to continuously check the City's website for updates on the validity period of advertised bids".

The extension of validity of Contract A-EE 14 -2024 was extended until 31 January 2025 and a further extension of validity is requested until 30 April 2025.

A further extension of validity is requested until 30 April 2025.

Any objections/disputes relating to this extension must be directed to Sisanda.Maya@ekurhuleni.gov.za on or before 23 January 2025.

It be noted that should no correspondence be received within 23 January 2025 the City will consider the bid offer/s valid for the stated period. – This must align with the 7 days mentioned in the policy therefore bidders must be given 7 days to respond and no response within the 7 days mean that the bid is valid.
