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**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF VALIDITY: FOR CONTRACT PS-PT 20-2024: THE APPOINTMENT OF AN INDEPENDENT FACILITATION TEAM FOR THE TRANSITION PROCESS OF THE INTEGRATED PUBLIC TRANSPORT NETWORK WITHIN THE CITY OF EKURHULENI ON AN AS AND WHEN REQUIRED BASIS FROM DATE OF AWARD UNTIL 30 JUNE 2027.**

The validity period for Contract number PS-PT 20-2024 will expire on 01 February 2025.

Paragraph 16.6.5 of the City of Ekurhuleni Supply Chain Management (SCM) Policy states that: *"SCM shall ensure that an extension of validity period is published on the City's website before the validity period expiry date. Should no response be received within 7 days, from date of publishing, the City will consider the bid offer/s valid for the stated period. It is the responsibility of a bidder to continuously check the City's website for updates on the validity period of advertised bids"*.
